### Introduction

Now in their fifth year, the Dynamic Place Awards celebrate excellence in place making and innovation. The Awards encourage quality of design, strong partnership working and inclusive approaches to regeneration and infrastructure development. In recognising projects which improve Scotland's economy, quality of life and environment, Scottish Enterprise, Highlands and Islands Enterprise, Scottish Natural Heritage and Communities Scotland fully support these Awards.

### Aims of the Dynamic Place Awards

The Awards are looking for projects which can demonstrate that they have contributed to the achievement of a Dynamic Place.

A Dynamic Place is a place which:

- has been transformed
- is an attractive place for people to live and work
- enriches peoples' lives
- demonstrates sustainability
- encourages economic growth

Projects must also demonstrate that they have maximised the potential of the place and the community.

### Award Categories

Awards will be given in each of the following categories.

#### 1. Built environment

- quality of design and/or refurbishment
- integration of built and unbuilt environments
- consideration of natural and cultural heritage
- innovative infrastructure (e.g. transport, energy, water)

#### 2. Community Development

- communities overcoming challenges
- improving/enhancing skills and employability
- enterprise development (including the provision of services to the local community and beyond)

#### 3. Connections

- connecting people to natural and cultural heritage
- connecting businesses to market and communities
- attracting people and talent
- promoting place, people, businesses

## Judges' Special Awards

At the discretion of the judges additional awards will recognise:

- Supreme Award, for a project that exemplifies the aims of the Dynamic Place Awards, demonstrates best practice and makes a major impact.
- Individual of the Year, for exceptional commitment, motivation and leadership
- Team of the Year, for exemplary partnership, co-operation and joint vision; and
- Sir Robert Grieve Award for, sustainability, demonstrating innovation, an ability to deliver a long term vision

## Who can Enter?

All appropriate projects completed between 2001 and 2005 are eligible to enter the Dynamic Place Awards, except those previously submitted to the Dynamic Place Awards. Entries are welcome from private and public sectors, utilities, communities, partnerships, and may be submitted by communities, partnerships, clients, users, designers or jointly.

## Entry Information

All entries should give a clear indication of the role of the client, consultant, designer, engineer etc.

Entries should include:

- a completed entry form,
- a single A4 sheet report and,
- supporting enclosures (hard copies of drawings, photos, published material, user statements, etc.)

## Judging Process

A high profile independent judging panel is assembled to judge the 2005 Dynamic Place Awards. This includes representatives from sponsors and specialists in their field. Short listed projects will be visited during September and October 2005. The Awards ceremony will be held on 24th November 2005 at Ratho Adventure Centre, West Lothian (2004 finalist).

Short listed projects are also invited to participate in a national Master Class during the day of the 24th November to celebrate success and promote mutual sharing and learning between projects.
